Reception (check in & check out)

Bedrooms/Housekeeping

We still want our bedrooms to feel like a home away from home for you but for the moment there are some small changes we have had to make. During your stay if there is anything you are not sure of, or wish to request extra services for your room, then please do ask us. Here are some measures you will see in your room:

- New cleaning procedures and equipment have been introduced to protect guests and staff working in our housekeeping teams
- Cleaning and sanitising will be carried out with an emphasis on high contact areas such as desks, chairs, remote controls, switches and handles
- We will not be servicing bedrooms during a guest's stay unless this is requested. Should you require replacement towels, tea/coffee tray items or toiletries, please contact reception.
- On departure, bedrooms are thoroughly aired
- We have removed clock radios, magazines, hotel directories and brochures from the bedrooms

Public Areas

Our lounge and public areas are still very much open for you to relax in. Whether your wish is to take some time out with a coffee and a good book you are more than welcome to take advantage of the public lounge, bar or outside terrace. Here is some measure you will see in and around the hotel:

- Sanitizing station in place at entry point of the hotel

- Doors and windows left open during the day to air the hotels (weather dependent)
- Enhance cleaning service in public toilets
